- 1. THE EXAMPLE OF JESUS 1 Peter 2:21 / Phillipians 2:5-8
 - a. We are called to follow Christ's example.
 - b. Jesus made Himself a servant.

Principle: Jesus is our example and He made Himself of no reputation

- 2. THE RESPONSIBLE FOR OUR INFLUENCE 1 Corinthians 8:13
 - a. We have a responsibility to others not just ourselves
- 3. THE CONSECRATION REASON Genesis 35:2-4 / Exodus 34:4; 35:5 / 1 Tim 2:9
- a. When Jacob /children of Israel rededicated themselves they removed jewelry.
- b. Christians should dress modestly, decently, and soberly.

Principle: A deeper relationship with God includes removing cosmetic jewelry

- 4. THE COMPARISON REASON Revelation 12 / Revelation 17
- a. The church is represented by no jewelry; the apostate is decked with jewelry

PRINCIPLE: Christ is to be glorified not us

- 5. THE TRANSLATION REASON Isaiah 65:17
- a. We will not wear cosmetic jewelry in heaven.

PRINCIPLE: Dress to please the Lord
